



POLICE DUTY



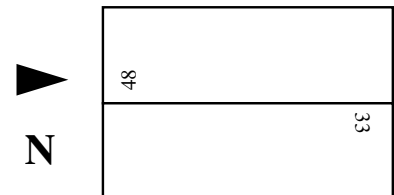
Ivie, Russia, July 5, 1944: The SS established a number of Police Armored Companies to assist in the pacification of the conquered territories in the east. The 2nd Police Armored Company was formed in the summer of 1942 with an established strength of 5 ADGZ armored cars and 5 Renault tanks. The Company was restructured in May 1943 with an additional ADGZ car and the replacement of the Renault tanks with the unusual PzIF a heavy, infantry tank on the Pz I frame. Late in 1943 the Armored Company was subordinated to the SS Police Regiment 4. On July 5, the SS Regiment was guarding the rail line in the vicinity of Ivie when it was attacked by around 1000 partisans armed with mortars and machine guns supported by tanks. Throughout the day a hard battle was fought and eventually the Germans pushed the Russians back. Two AT Guns and two tanks were destroyed by the Armored Company.

VICTORY CONDITIONS: The Russians win at game end if they control the Railroad building (SSR 2) and all buildings within 3 hexes of 48Q5 OR if they control the majority of building hexes on board 48.



BALANCE:

-  Add 2 447 squads to the German OOB.
-  Add one T60 M40 to the reinforcement Group.

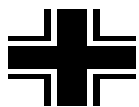
BOARD CONFIGURATION:

2nd Police Armored Company, SS Police Regiment 4, von Gottberg Battle Group: set up on/ west of 3 hexes east of the railroad:

Enter on Turn 4 on the east board edge, north of the railroad:

SCENARIO SPECIFIC RULES:

1. EC are Moderate with no wind in effect. Kindling is NA.
2. Add overlays RR1 on 33AA4-Z4, RR2 on 33P9-O10, RR3 on 48U10-V9, RR4 on 48Z7-AA7 and RR5 on 48EE5-FF4. 33Q8/Q9, 33Q9/Q10 and 33Q9/R9 are road hexsides. Building 33R7 is the railroad building.
3. The Germans are SS. The Partisans are considered Russian for all purposes. Russian Guns do not set up emplaced.
4. The PzIF and the ADGZ are not currently in the ASL system. Substitute 4x PSW 222(L) for the 4x ADGZ AC. Use a Pz IB counter with the following changes for the PzIF: AF=6/4 with circled 4, weight is 21.1 tons, MP is 9.
